Customer

A public school district in the Southeast with 30 schools, 15,000 students, and 2,300 employees.

Background

The school district is required by their state to physically inventory and report on all fixed assets annually. Over 20,000 fixed assets must be inventoried and accounted for annually including IT assets, vehicles, cafeteria equipment, maintenance equipment & tools, furniture, and a wide variety of other assets.

The Problem

The district was relying on a manual process to inventory the assets that took so long, it had been at least 2 years since one had been completed. It involved printing asset reports and then manually locating and inventorying each asset. The process took so long that assets would move around within the school before the inventory could be completed, making the process more difficult and sometimes inaccurate.



The Solution



inLogic helped evaluate the wide variety of assets they planned to tag. Some of their unique tag requirements included tags that could be placed on assets that stayed outdoors and tags that could withstand high temperatures. Ultimately they standardized on 2 different types of tags from

Confidex. By opting to go with fewer tag types and increase the quantity of each type required, they were able to significantly reduce the cost per tag and stay within their budget. The school district chose to implement RFTTrack.NET On-Demand, a hosted subscription option, to reduce the up-front capital expense and minimize the amount of IT infrastructure and administration required to maintain the system.

The Result

The efficiencies gained by implementing RFID not only allow the school district to easily complete their mandated annual inventory, it also allows them to perform more frequent inventories resulting in improved asset visibility and accountability.
